Rules of Entry

Who can play?

Strata Management delegates can participate in the trade passport and door prizes promotion.

Entry requirements

Trade Passport:

Visit all of the exhibition booths to learn about their products and/or services.
The exhibition booth representatives complete your trade passport.

Delegates must submit their fully completed Trade Passport to the registration desk with their names noted on the Trade Passport before 1.40pm on 5 July 2024.

Exhibitor Door Prizes:

Submit your business card or complete the online entry at participating exhibition booths to enter the participating exhibitor door prize draw.

By submitting your entry, you are granting permission for the exhibitor to contact you for follow-up and marketing purposes.

Unclaimed prizes

Trade Passport:

The winner must be present at the draw. In the event that the winner is not in attendance to claim the Trade Passport prize, a redraw will take place to select an alternate winner. The draw will be conducted in a fair and transparent manner to ensure equal opportunity for all entrants.

Exhibitor Door Prizes:

In the event that the original winner is not in attendance to claim the door prize, it is at the discretion of the Exhibitor to choose to deliver the prize or conduct a redraw. Draws will be conducted in a fair and transparent manner to ensure equal opportunity for all entrants.
