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NEW LAWS ALLOW OWNERS CORPORATIONS, EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES AND MANAGING AGENTS TO CONDUCT TELEVISED MEETINGS DURING COVID-19

Strata Community Association (ACT) President Chris Miller has welcomed new regulations allowing owners corporations, executive committees and managing agents to hold televised meetings during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The ACT Government has introduced the regulation made under Section 11 of the [Unit Titles \(Management\) Regulation 2011](#) and is effective from today, May 1, 2020.

Mr Miller said the changes would support owners' corporations to continue to fulfil their legal obligations to hold regular meetings, while observing the physical distancing requirements.

Mr Miller wrote to ACT Planning and Land Management Minister Mick Gentleman Minister in March seeking urgent action to protect the well-being of owners and managers and asked the Government to allow video conferencing.
